



Fast Growing Trees

Customers often ask for a tree that “grows fast”. How much is “fast”? According to horticulture industry authority Michael Dirr plant growth rates are defined as follows:

Fast: 25” or more per year.

Medium: 13”-24” per year

Slow: 12” or less per year

Since we are a supplier of plant material to professional landscapers as well as to the public many of our trees are already “landscape” size and will immediately provide the benefits of a good-sized tree. Also, many trees of a smaller trunk diameter are just as tall as those of a larger trunk diameter but cost less and recover from transplant shock faster.
